Head Lice (Be Proactive)

It is around this time of year that we have a few occurrences of head lice in our schools.

Remember that head lice are a nuisance; they do not carry disease and are not a health risk. They also do not mean your child is dirty; anyone may become infested by them. Early detection and appropriate treatment, will significantly limit the spread of head lice in our school.

At this time, it is suggested that you avoid using head lice shampoos; they no longer kill all lice and their nits, and they may cause skin irritation. Inexpensive conditioner and special lice combs, when used as directed, will quickly eliminate lice from your child's head. Hair conditioner and lice combs are available at most drug stores. More information is available from the Public Health Nurse (755-3345).

Growth Mind Set - What is it?

Growth mindset is believing we can get smarter through hard work and good strategies.

When students believe they can get smarter, they understand that effort makes them stronger. This is important in facing and solving problems across all disciplines and areas inside and outside of school.
